## Progressive supranuclear palsy initially misdiagnosed as Hashimoto encephalopathy

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**Background:** Progressive supranuclear palsy (PSP) is a parkinsonism-plus syndrome most frequently manifesting with postural instability. Hashimoto encephalopathy (HE) is an immune-mediated encephalopathy associated with Hashimoto thyroiditis with anti-TPO antibodies being the major marker. HE is presented mainly with psychiatric symptoms and seizures, meanwhile, parkinsonian features are possible at the presentation.

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
